Branches	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Texas State Bank branches will close at normal business hours on Friday, February 1• Texas State branches will be closed Saturday–Sunday, February 2–3• Texas State Bank branches open as American State Bank branches on Monday, February 4 and will continue to operate during their normal business hours
ATM access/ Debit Cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• American State Bank ATM/debit cards will be mailed during the week of January 14• Use your Texas State Bank ATM/debit card to access funds through Sunday, February 3—after this date your card will be deactivated and should be destroyed• Activate your American State Bank debit card on Monday, February 4 (see page 4 of the enclosed brochure for instructions)
Checks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upon completion of the merger you can continue to use your Texas State Bank checks and deposit slips unless your account number is changing• You will be notified prior to Monday, February 4 if your account number is changing. If it is, we will provide you with new checks, free of charge
Online & Mobile Banking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Before February 1, download or print copies of your electronic statement and transaction history, including bill payment history• As of 3:00 p.m. on Friday, February 1, Texas State Bank online banking, mobile banking and bill pay will be available for inquiry only until Monday, February 4• Starting on Monday, February 4, get started with online banking at asbtx.com and download the American State Bank mobile banking app
Telephone Banking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Texas State telephone banking will be available through Sunday, February 3—after this date please dial 866.582.8440 for all your telephone banking needs
Loans	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Because branches will be closed on Saturday, February 2, make any loan payments that are paid in branch by Friday, February 1
